

**NOTICE**  
**Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act**

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Samuel and Rosanna Kendrick House  
4822 Nineteenth Avenue  
Markham, ON

The Samuel and Rosanna Kendrick House has design and physical value as locally rare example of a vernacular farmhouse in the Georgian architectural tradition with a kitchen sidewing. The Samuel and Rosanna Kendrick House has historical value or associative value, representing the religious and cultural mosaic theme of Pennsylvania German Mennonites being attracted to Markham Township, and also the theme of improvement to nineteenth century farmsteads as the agricultural community progressed past the early settlement phase. Further, the property has contextual value as a former farmhouse located in a semi-rural community east of the historic hamlet of Almira, historically linked to the property where it has stood since the mid-1850s.
