

NOTICE
Intention to Designate a Property / Ontario Heritage Act

The Council of the City of Markham intends to designate the following property for reasons of cultural heritage value or interest pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990*, Chapter O.18, Part IV:

Dickson Hill Mill House
81 Dickson Hill Road
Markham, ON

The Dickson Hill Mill House has design and physical value as a representative example of a mid-nineteenth century vernacular dwelling designed in the Georgian architectural tradition. The Dickson Hill Mill House has historical and associative value, representing the theme of industry, innovation and economic development because of its association with the Dickson Hill Mill, an important local industry that operated from 1842 until 1954, and with the Dickson family who owned the property from 1842 to 1870. Further, the dwelling has contextual value as one of several heritage buildings that are important in defining, maintaining and supporting the character and extent of the historic hamlet of Dickson Hill.

Any person may notify the City of Markham of their objection in writing, which shall include the reasons for their objection and all relevant facts, **on or before 4:30 p.m. October 16, 2023** to be sent by registered mail or dropped off in person to:
