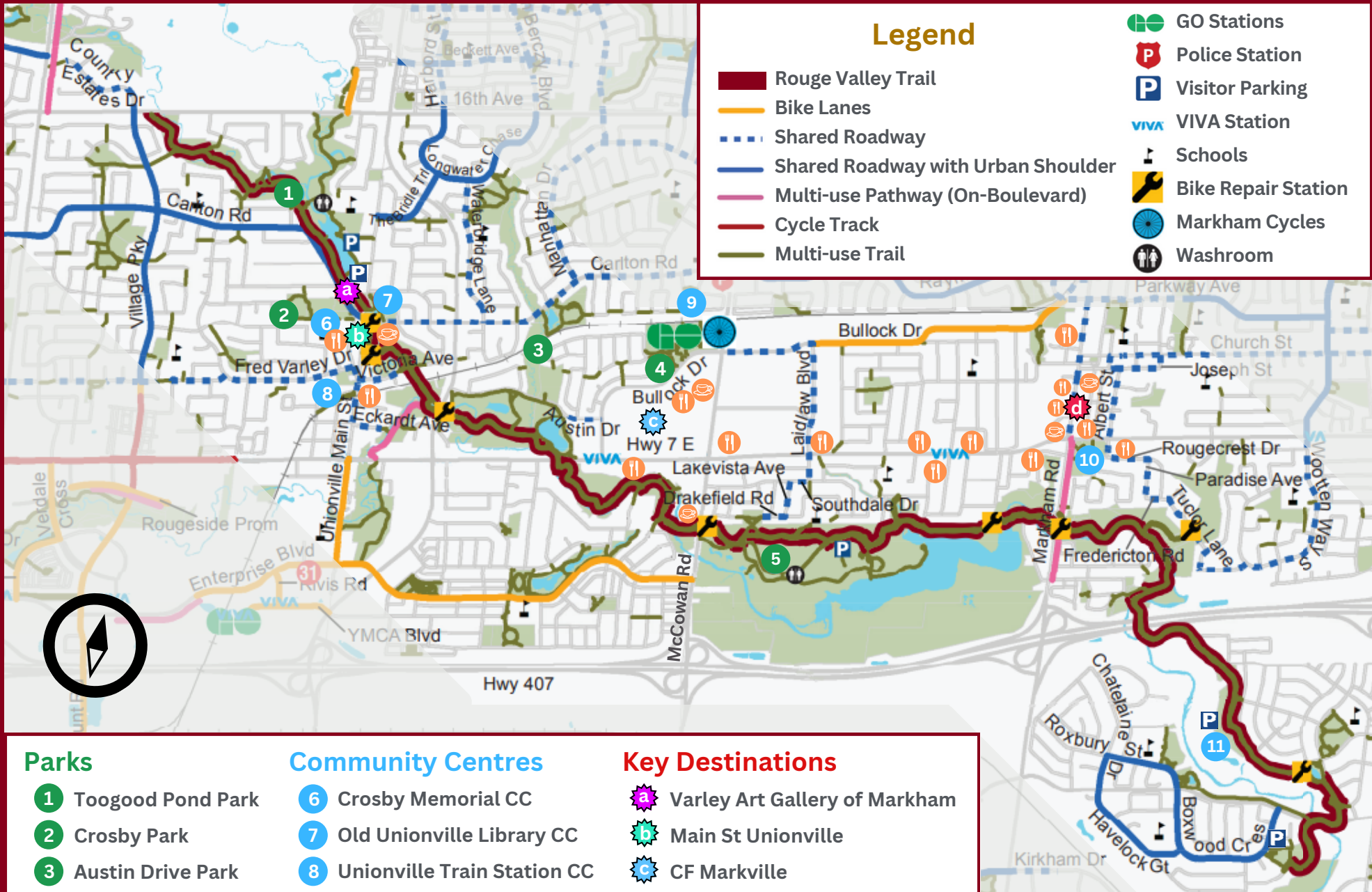
The Markham Rouge Valley Trail follows the Rouge River along **Toogood Pond** located in the heart of **Unionville**, continues south to **Austin Drive Park**, connects through **Milne Dam Conservation Park** to east of Markham Road under Highway 407 to 14th Avenue near 9th Line, with plans to extend to **Rouge National Urban Park**.
